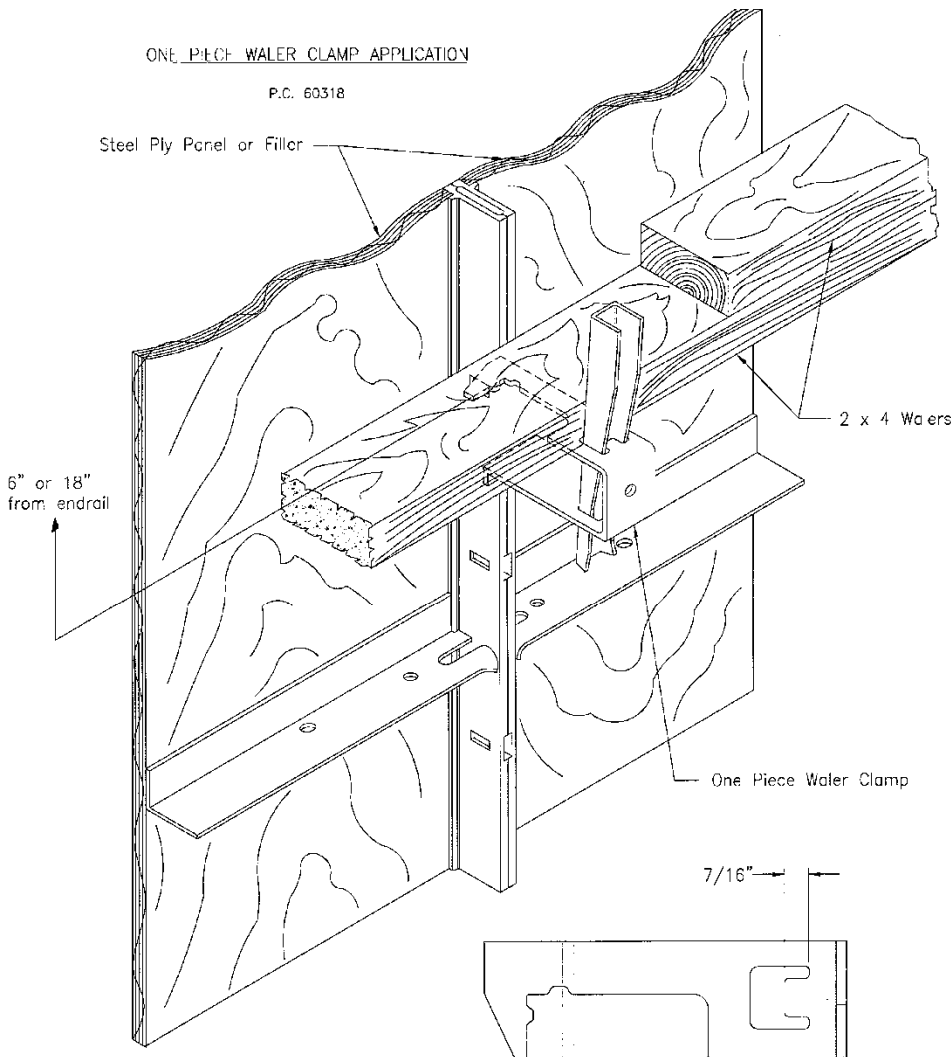

FORM ALIGNMENT: PART 1-WALERS



WALERS ARE USED FOR ALIGNMENT BASICALLY, AND IN MOST CASES DO NOT ADD TO THE STRUCTURAL ABILITY TO HOLD CONCRETE. BECAUSE OF THIS FACT, ONLY ONE SIDE OF THE FORMWORK SHOULD BE WALED. NORMALLY 2"X4" LUMBER IS USED FOR WALING MATERIAL. A TYPICAL WALER IS COMPRISED OF DOUBLE 2"X4"s, BUT THEY NEED NOT BE NAILED TOGETHER. WHEN APPLICABLE, 16' LENGTHS OF STRAIGHT LUMBER IS RECOMMENDED WITH THE JOINTS STAGGERED TO PROVIDE CONTINUOUS ALIGNMENT.
